By paying the registration fees on the show directly or after the close of registration there will be additional fees of EUR 10,-. The dog-owners who had registered their dogs and did not pay the registration fees must pay the registration fee even if they did not come to the ring (expect the dead of the dog)! Without paying the fee (all unpaid), will not be possible to register to any further shows organized by WHCÖ. After sending the registration form you will get a confirmation. If you did not receive a confirmation within 10 days after sending the registration form please contact the registration office.

Health Conditions

All dogs must have a PET PASSPORT with valid vaccinations against rabies at least 21 days by the length of validity of the vaccine. The owner must on the request the organizer show a valid certificate of vaccination of every individual which is brought to the exhibition, even if it is was not judged on the show.

The dog-owner/dog-handler is responsible for exhibiting the dog timely. The correct catalogue number must be worn viewable by the dog-handler.

Classes

0. Baby Class, younger than 6 months
1. Puppy Class, 6-9 months
2. Junior Class, 9-18 months
3. Intermediate Class 15-24 months
4. Open Class, from 15 months
5. Working Class from 15 months
6. Champion Class, from 15 month
7. Veterans Class, 8 years and older

The required age of the dog must be completed at the day before the show.

Please check the catalogue, if correctly entered your dog to class. Reclassification to another class is possible only if mistake was done by organisator. In case of incorrect classification in registration will be the dog automatically placed in the appropriate class according to age, older than 15 months will be automatically included in the open class.

Documents received after the last entry close will not accepted. Exhibitor undertakes to pay entry fees even if he will not participate at the show whatever the reason (except the death of the animal).

Registrations lacking any necessary documents (e.g. Scan of championship certificate, working certificate,...) will be without chasing entered into open class.

Titles and Championship Expaniances

Best Junior

Expectant for the Austrian junior champion can get male and female with Excellent 1 in junior class.

CACA and CACA Reserve

Expectant for the Austrian champion can get a male and female with Excellent 1 in intermediate, open, working and champion class. Reserve CACA can get a male and female with Excellent 2 in intermediate, open, working and champion class, while in the class was given CACA.

Best Veteran

Expectant for the Austrian veterans champion can get male and female with Excellent 1 in veterans class.

Best Dog – Best Bitch

Awarded separately male and female. Given to one out of CACA in intermediate, open, working and champion class, the V1 in veterans class and the Best Juniors.

BOB - Best of breed

Given to one out of titles Best Junior, CACA and both winners of the veterans class.

BOS – Best of Opposite Sex

Given to one out of titles Best Junior, CACA, and winner of veteran class of the opposite sex as BOB.

Competitions

Best Breeding Group

For at least 3 dogs and maximum 5 dogs, which were judged at the show, coming from one breeder (one kennel name). They may not be in same ownership (we recommend dogs from junior class and up – but it is not term).

Best Couple

For male and female owned by same owner, both have been judged at the show.

Terms of Show

Females in heat, in second half of the pregnancy and breast feeding females are excluded from show. Dogs bearing sign of skin or other transmissible diseases, also dogs after surgical procedure to remove defects of exterior are also excluded from the show. Infringements will result in exclusion from the current and the following exhibitions organized by WHCÖ.

The judge must disqualify aggressive dogs. It is forbidden to stand dog against dog (incitement), loud cheering (double handling) from outside the ring. Kit is prohibited to use any products that alter structure, colour and appearance of hair, skin or nose. Only trimming, cutting and combing are allowed.

If the show is cancelled for unforeseen reasons, the entry fees are used to cover the costs. The show will take place in every weather. Organizers assumes no responsibility for any illness, loss or death of a dog. Also are not responsible for any damages or injury caused by the dog/ to the dog at the time of the show. The owner assumes all responsibility for damages caused by the dog. On the show organizer is entitled to not accept a dog only in justified situation.
